PLEASE NOTE LEFT AND RIGHT ARE DETERMINED BY FACING THE ALTAR WITH LEFT BEING THE ALTAR SERVER SIDE AND RIGHT BEING THE ORGAN/ CHOIR SIDE.

The setup EM will place an empty ciborium on the credence table. If there is overflow, Father will fill it from the tabernacle ciborium and give it to the overflow EM.

The overflow EM should check with the ushers to see if there is overflow, The best time would be during the sign of peace. It would work best if you would notify the head usher, usually Jim Tomsic, and he can let you know if he knows who you are and where you are sitting.

The overflow EM will come up to the altar with the other EMs on the LEFT side so as to follow the two altar servers after receiving the Eucharist.

The overflow EM will proceed back to the Parish Hall following the two altar servers who are assigned candles. The candles will stand one on each side of the EM when he/she distributes Eucharist.

When returning to the church from the Parish Hall, stop and see if there is anyone in the gathering space that requires communion. Also give it to the altar servers. Then the altar servers can return to their seats up a side isle.

The overflow EM can also distribute to any handicapped that are in the rear of the church before returning to the front of the church to return their ciborium to the altar.
