The word Chrismon is a contraction of the two words—Christ and monogram. Christian monograms have been used throughout the ages as signs of the Christian faith. All Chrismons are made in a combination of white—for the purity of Christ—and gold—for the majesty of Christ. Each monogram has a meaning of its own. Using Christian symbols to decorate a Christmas tree is a way of showing the deep spiritual meaning of Christmas.

TO THE PARENTS OF OUR YOUNG CHILDREN, MAY WE SUGGEST...

Relax! God put the wiggle in children; don't feel you have to suppress it in God's house. All are welcome!

Sit toward the front where it is easier for your little one to see and hear what's going on at the altar. They tire of seeing the backs of others' heads.

Quietly explain the parts of the Mass and actions of the priest, altar servers, cantor, etc...

Sing the hymns, pray and voice the responses. Children learn liturgical behavior by copying you.

If you have to leave Mass because your child is inconsolably crying or screaming for more than 30 seconds, feel free to do so; once he/she has calmed down, please bring them back. As Jesus said, "Let the children come to me."

Remember that the way we welcome children in church directly affects the way they respond to the Church, to God, and to one another. Let them know that they are at home in this house of worship.
