# THE TREE OF LIFE Add a Leaf and Watch It Grow!

This beautiful MEMORIAL TREE is located in the Gathering Space of the beautiful St. James the Younger Catholic Church in Conway, South Carolina. The tree has a bronze trunk and brass and bronze leaves. Foundation stones around the base are made of bronze.

The TREE OF LIFE provides an opportunity to perpetuate the memory or give special honor to a loved one in a way which both gives glory to God and helps our church. Many people have chosen to dedicate leaves or a foundation stone in memory of a deceased parent, child, or other special person. In other cases, the tree has been chosen as a way to specially honor persons on special occasions, for example 80<sup>th</sup> birthday, 50<sup>th</sup> wedding anniversary, retirement, etc. This is a living tree, which can grow continuously, so dedications are always welcome!

Leaves are engraved for donations of \$250 for a brass leaf and \$500 and up for a bronze leaf. Foundation stones are laid for donations of \$2,500 for a small stone and \$5,000 for a large stone. Upon request, a personal announcement can be sent to whomever the donor designates.
