**KNOW YOUR FAITH**  
**ALTAR LINENS & VESSELS –PART 2**

**Conopaeum**—a veil used to cover the Tabernacle.

**Pyx**-the name of a small case used to transport the Eucharist to the sick or homebound.

**The Cruets**-small bottles or vessels that contain the water and wine poured into the chalice used by the priest at the Consecration of the Mass.

**The Veil**-covers the chalice, purification, pall and corporals used by the priest, symbolizing the Tabernacle.

**Conopaeum:** un velo usado para cubrir el Tabernáculo.

**Pyx:** el nombre de un pequeño estuche que se usa para transportar la Eucaristía a los enfermos o onfinados en casa.

**Las vinagreras:** pequeñas botellas o recipientes que contienen el agua y el vino que se vierten en el cáliz.

que usa el sacerdote en la consagración de la misa.

**El Velo:** cubre el cáliz, la purificación, el velo y los corporales utilizados por el sacerdote, simbolizando el Tabernáculo.
