BISHOP JULIO HERNANDO GARCIA PELAEZ: He is the bishop of Fr. Oscar's home diocese of Garagoa, Colombia. This diocese has sent priests to the Diocese of Charleston for over 30 years. In 1978, he entered the Major Seminary of Manizales, where he studied the first year of philosophy. Once the Major Seminary of Pereira was founded, in 1979, it was transferred to this new priestly formation center; There he concluded the philosophical cycle and did two years of Theology. Later, he was sent to Rome to complete his theology studies at the Pontifical Gregorian University. At the end of the same, advanced the Licentiate in Patristic Theology. Already a Presbyter, he carried out some specialization studies in Human Rights at the University of Quindío. He received Priestly Ordination in Rome, from the hands of His Holiness John Paul II, on June 2, 1985, and was incardinated in the Diocese of Pereira. During almost 20 years of exercising the priestly ministry, he has held the following positions: Chancellor of the Diocese of Pereira and Parochial Vicar of the Cathedral (1986-1992). Rector of the "Maria Inmaculada" Major Seminary of the Diocese of Pereira (1992-2001). Pastoral Vicar of the Diocese (2002-2003). Pastor of the Cathedral (2004 – 2005)

He has also served as Professor at the Popular Catholic University of Risaralda, Delegate for University Pastoral Care (1989) and Delegate for Pastoral Care with the elderly (1992).

On February 11, 2005, His Holiness John Paul II appointed him Auxiliary Bishop of the Archdiocese of Cali and his Episcopal Ordination took place in Pereira on April 2, 2005.

On June 5, 2010, Pope Benedict XVI named him Bishop of the Diocese of Istmina-Tadó.

On June 15, 2017, His Holiness, Pope Francis, appointed Monsignor Julio Hernando García Peláez as Bishop of Garagoa, until now Bishop of Istmina-Tadó.

OBISPO JULIO HERNANDO GARCIA PELAEZ: Es obispo del P. La diócesis de origen de Oscar de Garagoa, Colombia. Esta diócesis ha enviado sacerdotes a la Diócesis de Charleston por más de 30 años. En 1978 ingresó al Seminario Mayor de Manizales, donde cursó el primer año de Filosofía. Una vez fundado el Seminario Mayor de Pereira, en 1979, fue trasladado a este nuevo centro de formación sacerdotal; Allí concluyó el ciclo filosófico y realizó dos años de Teología. Posteriormente, fue enviado a Roma para completar sus estudios de teología en la Pontificia Universidad Gregoriana. Al término de la misma, avanzó la Licenciatura en Teología Patristica. Ya presbítero, realizó algunos estudios de especialización en Derechos Humanos en la Universidad del Quindío. Recibió la Ordenación Sacerdotal en Roma, de manos de Su Santidad Juan Pablo II, el 2 de junio de 1985, y fue incardinado en la Diócesis de Pereira. Durante casi 20 años de ejercicio del ministerio sacerdotal ha ocupado los siguientes cargos: Canciller de la Diócesis de Pereira y Vicario Parroquial de la Catedral (1986-1992).

Rector del Seminario Mayor "María Inmaculada" de la Diócesis de Pereira (1992-2001).

Vicario Pastoral de la Diócesis (2002-2003).

Párroco de la Catedral (2004 – 2005)

También se ha desempeñado como Profesor de la Universidad Católica Popular de Risaralda, Delegado de Pastoral Universitaria (1989) y Delegado de Pastoral del Adulto Mayor (1992).

El 11 de febrero de 2005 Su Santidad Juan Pablo II lo nombró Obispo Auxiliar de la Arquidiócesis de Cali y su Ordenación Episcopal tuvo lugar en Pereira el 2 de abril de 2005.

El 5 de junio de 2010, el Papa Benedicto XVI lo nombró obispo de la diócesis de Istmina-Tadó.

El 15 de junio de 2017, Su Santidad el Papa Francisco, nombró obispo de Garagoa a monseñor Julio Hernando García Peláez, hasta ahora obispo de Istmina-Tadó.
