With Memorial Day approaching, the Knights considered it appropriate that the following little-known information be imparted to our parish veterans.



Veterans Saluting Flags

It has been over 11 years since one of the Government's most appreciative actions regarding veterans was enacted, yet sadly this patriotic measure is not widely known. President George W. Bush wanted a way for veterans to be recognized in public during events where the American flag was paraded and/or the National Anthem was sung. On October 14, 2009 he signed the Defense Authorization Act of 2009 which contained a provision changing the US Code and <u>authorizing Armed forces personnel in civilian clothes and VETERANS to render the hand salute while remaining covered (outdoors) / uncovered (indoors) in order to honor the flag, instead of placing their hand over their heart like civilians are encouraged to do. This law embodied in the change to the US Code applies to all honorably discharged veterans, be they one-term enlistees/draftees or military retirees and every veteran in between.</u>
