Liturgy of the Eucharist —Part 1

Gifts to the Altar—The bread and wine and our monetary donations in support of the Church represent the offering of ourselves and all we have to the Lord. Our gifts are united with our Savior's perfect gift of Himself.

"Lift up your hearts"—done since earliest times, we are invited to lift up or open our hearts to Heaven as the priest lifts up our gifts. We are taken up in spirit to Heaven.

Eucharistic Prayer/Anaphora—Epiclesis—the priest places his hands over the gifts and calls down the Holy Spirit to change the bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Jesus.

The Narrative of Institution— the moment when the Spirit and the Word transform the bread and wine into the Body and blood, Soul. And Divinity of Jesus Christ (Transubstantiation). The priest, who is speaking in the person of Christ, relates the drama of the Last Supper

Liturgia de la Eucaristía —Parte 1

Ofrendas al Altar: el pan y el vino y nuestras donaciones monetarias en apoyo de la Iglesia representan la ofrenda de nosotros mismos y de todo lo que tenemos al Señor. Nuestros dones están unidos con el don perfecto de nuestro Salvador de sí mismo.

"Levantad vuestros corazones", hecho desde tiempos remotos, se nos invita a levantar o abrir nuestros corazones al Cielo como el sacerdote levanta nuestros dones. Somos llevados en espíritu al Cielo.

Plegaria Eucarística/Anáfora—Epiclesis — el sacerdote coloca sus manos sobre las ofrendas e invoca al Espíritu Santo para que cambie el pan y el vino en el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Jesús.

La Narrativa de Institución — el momento en que el Espíritu y la Palabra transforman el pan y el vino en el Cuerpo y la sangre, el Alma. Y Divinidad de Jesucristo (Transubstanciación). El sacerdote, que habla en la persona de Cristo, relata el drama de la Última Cena.
