

WAYNE COCKFIELD

Wavne Cockfield is treasurer of the National Right to Life Committee and Vice President for Medical Ethics. He also serves as an at-large director on the NRLC Board and on the Executive Committee. Since, 1996, Wayne has worked with the NRLC to promote public awareness of the present and growing threat of euthanasia and physician assisted suicide. Wayne has addressed the National Conference of Pro-Life Legislators in Washington, D.C. and been a featured speaker at numerous pro-life events. He has appeared on C-Span, MSNBC, CNN United Nations Radio and has been quoted in numerous publications including the National Catholic Register, the New York Times, the Washington Times, c-Fam, and the European Life Network News. Born in South Carolina, Wayne served with the Marine Corp in Vietnam until gravely wounded in action in November 1969. He received the Bronze Star with V for heroism. Mr. Cockfield travels extensively speaking out for protection of medically vulnerable people including the poor, the elderly, the disabled, and those who are chronically and terminally ill.
