### STEWARDSHIP PRAYER

### MAY IS NATIONAL STROKE AWARENESS MONTH!

A stroke occurs when blood supply to the brain is cut off. Every 40 seconds someone in the U.S. has a stroke. Fortunately 80% of strokes are preventable. It is important to stay physically active, stop smoking, control high blood pressure, diabetes, cholesterol, weight and atrial fibrillation (commonly called A-Fib). When stroke occurs, emergent care is critical. Act F.A.S.T. to recognize signs:

**F-** Face- does one side of the face droop when smiling?

**A-** Arms- when raised does one arm drift downward

**S-** Speech- is speech slurred or strange?

**T-** Time- if any of these signs are present, call 9-1-1 immediately and note the time. Most treatments work best if started within 3 hours of first symptoms.
