- In the Exodus, the unleavened bread is the remembrance of the manna in the desert when the Israelites hastily departed from Egypt.
- The "cup of blessing" -the wine at the end of the Jewish Passover meal signifies the Messianic expectation of the rebuilding of Jerusalem
- The multiplication of the loaves prefigures the Eucharist
- The water turned into wine at the wedding at Cana announces the Hour of Jesus' glorification
