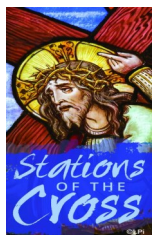


Tidey Whitey Drive

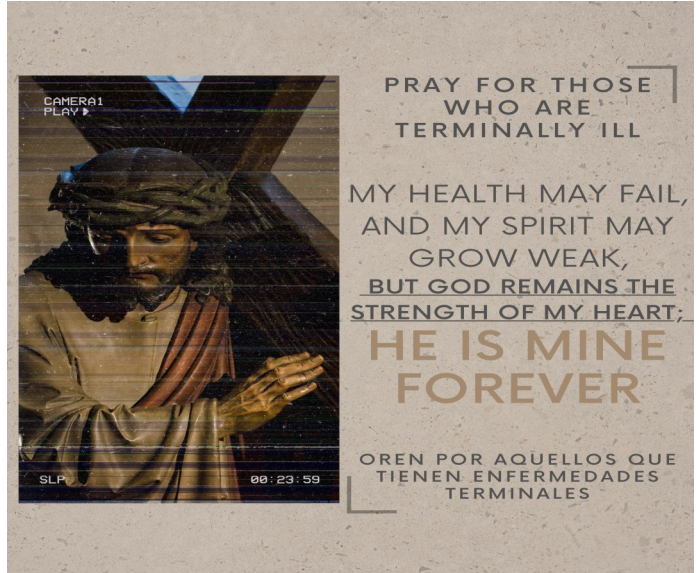


Youth Ministry

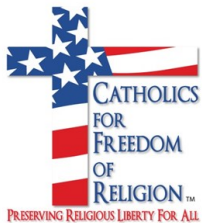
