This is the proper name for what is sometimes mistakenly called "Last Rites" or "Extreme Unction." It is meant for anyone who has a serious illness, is facing surgery, or even is dealing with the effects of old age. It should not be limited to the dying. As the Letter of James says clearly, "Are there any who are sick among you? Let them send for the priests of the church and let the priests pray over them, anointing them with oil in the name of the Lord...." It is a sacrament of healing for spirit, mind, and often body. It is administered at a monthly Mass, usually on the first Wednesday, and anytime on request.



ST. JAMES COLUMBARIUM

With the final three niche units (Units B, D & F) install for our columbarium, we have seven such units now in place. We have a total of 336 niches in the columbarium. We still have niches available. Remember each niche, which measures 12" x 12" x 12", can hold two cremated remains. The cost for a niche is 2,900 with 2,000 of that amount being tax deductible. If you have not already thought about our columbarium as a final resting place, now may be the time to begin. Take a minute and visit our beautiful Columbarium located on sacred grounds.
