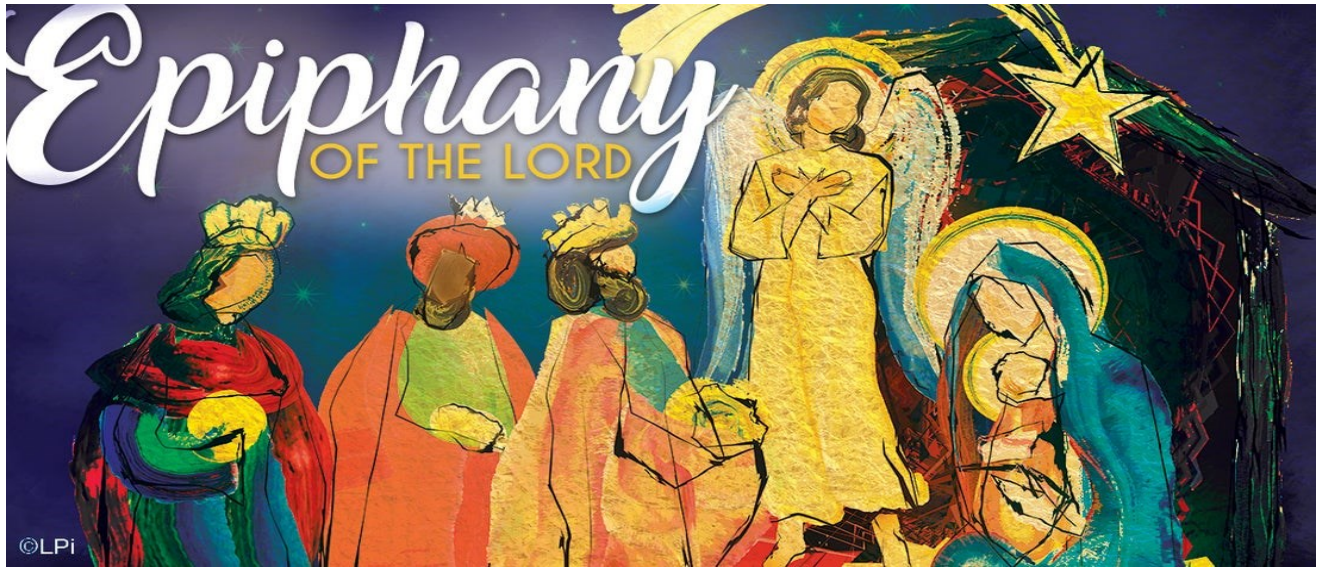
### BLACK CATHOLICS HERITAGE CELEBRATION 2024
