MEN'S RETREAT—JANUARY 21, 2023

The Men of St. Joseph is our men's ministry. We are doing a one-day retreat called **LEAD** (Listen, Embrace, Assume, Discover) on Saturday, January 21.

LEAD speaks to men of all ages and conveys truths that are not often discussed in a regular church setting. Many men, young or old, will hear key concepts and life-altering truths for the first time. Whether you are young and hope to be married, are currently married, or are a father whose children have left home, LEAD is for all men of all ages.

Fatherhood is not so much biological as it is spiritual. Any man can be a biological dad, but it takes a real man to be a spiritual father. LEAD is a roadmap for all men who are longing for the answers to their identity and God-given destiny and answers fundamental questions such as:

- 1) What is my location and importance in God's plan?
- 2) Is my role as a man any different than a woman's?
- 3) What is the first step to becoming a man of glory?
- 4) What four components constitute a true man of greatness?




