SAFE ENVIRONMENT

Did you know that the Diocese of Charleston has had a policy on how to address allegations of sexual misconduct against children by Church personnel since 1994? The policy was updated in 2003 to comply with the USCCB's original Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People. The policy was revised again in 2012. This policy, called the **Policy Concerning Allegations of Sexual Misconduct or Abuse of a Minor by Church Personnel** and the **Code of Conduct for Church Personnel** is used in all diocesan parishes and schools. Church Personnel, in this context, refers to all volunteers with regular access with minors, as well as all Catholic clergy, religious sisters and brothers, seminarians, and lay employees. All of the above individuals must read and sign an acknowledgement of receipt of the Policy and agree to abide by it. In addition, all must sign and agree to abide by the Code of Conduct. These documents, and more pertaining to the diocesan and parish efforts to maintain a safe environment for children, are available in the Youth Ministry Office at St. James, as well as online at the diocesan website: charlestandiocese.org. 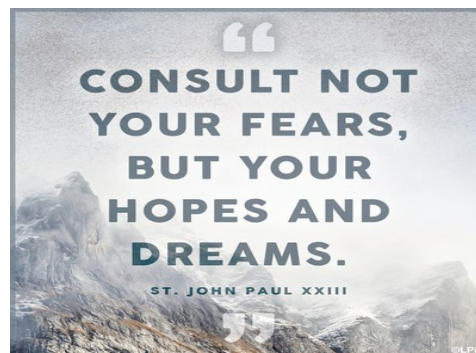

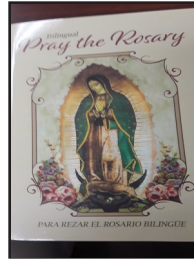

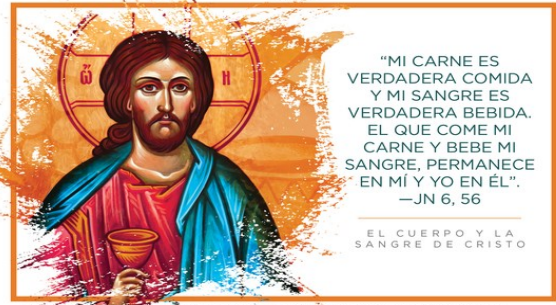
