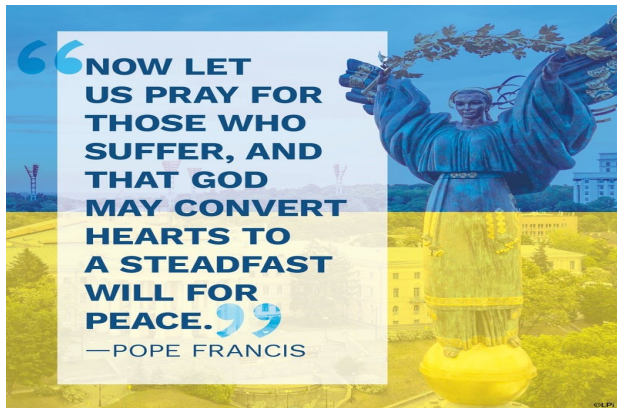
KNOW YOUR FAITH

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK REQUEST: This is the proper name for what is sometimes mistakenly called “Last Rites” or “Extreme Unction.” It is meant for anyone who has a serious illness, is facing surgery, or even is dealing with the effects of old age. It should not be limited to the dying. As the Letter of James says clearly, “Are there any who are sick among you? Let them send for the priests of the Church, and let the priests pray over them, anointing them with oil in the name of the Lord...” It is a sacrament of healing for spirit, mind, and often body. It is administered at a monthly Mass, usually on the first Wednesday, and anytime on request.

ST. JAMES COLUMBARIUM

With the final three niche units (Units B, D & F) install for our columbarium, we have seven such units now in place. We have a total of 336 niches in the columbarium. We still have niches available. Remember each niche, which measures 12" x 12" x 12", can hold two cremated remains. The cost for a niche is \$2,900 with \$2,000 of that amount being tax deductible. If you have not already thought about our columbarium as a final resting place, now may be the time to begin. Take a minute and visit our beautiful Columbarium located on sacred grounds. GOD'S GIFT OF *Consciousness*

presented by Dr. Phil Michels, Ph.D.

Tuesday, July 5 at 6:00 PM

This talk is designed to draw people closer to God and help them cope with difficult times. The importance of thoughts and the development of a method to evolve from "good ideas" (with the help of the Holy Spirit) to REALIZING is emphasized.

SEMINAR "GOD'S GIFT OF CONSCIOUSNESS"

Phil Michels, Ph.D. is offering a free 1 ½ hour seminar, "God's Gift of Consciousness"--to draw people closer to God and help cope with difficult times. The importance of thoughts and the development of a method to evolve from "good ideas" (with the help of the Holy Spirit) to REALIZING is emphasized. Preparation began over 20 years ago with the topic, "Compliance: How to Influence People to Take Better Care of Themselves" which was given around the country to varied audiences with consistently excellent feedback. Based on "consciousness" Dr. Michels developed a free quit smoking program which ran monthly from 1999-2019 at Palmetto Richland Memorial and Palmetto Baptist Hospitals (Prisma Health). Annual success rates over the 20 years ranged from 77%-89%. Follow-up data six months - 2 years later revealed that over 50% of program participants never smoked again. These success rates were over 400 times better than the national average compared with other smoking cessation programs. With God's help, the presentation has evolved in spiritual dimension and application. God's blessings have never been more obvious and alive—a message at the heart of the talk. In way of background, Dr. Michels taught as full-time Tenured Professor and Director of Behavioral Medicine at the USC School of Medicine's Department of Family Medicine. Currently, he is in full-time private practice as a clinical psychologist.

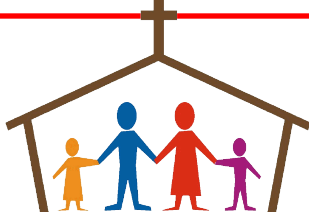
