



## PARISH NURSE HEALTH AWARENESS TIP FOR MARCH IS Colon Cancer Awareness Month

Those age 45 and over should schedule a preventive colonoscopy. Colon Cancer usually begins as small non cancerous polyps that can be removed by colonoscopy if found before they become cancerous. Symptoms to be aware of are 1) change in bowel habits 2) rectal bleeding 3) stomach discomfort, persistent cramps, gas and belly pain 4) unexplained weight loss 5) tiredness and weakness. Contact your primary care doctor for further evaluation and the American Cancer Society for more information regarding this topic.

- What do you want everyone to know about the Eucharist? Are there any stories of your encounter with Christ in the Eucharist that you would like to share?




