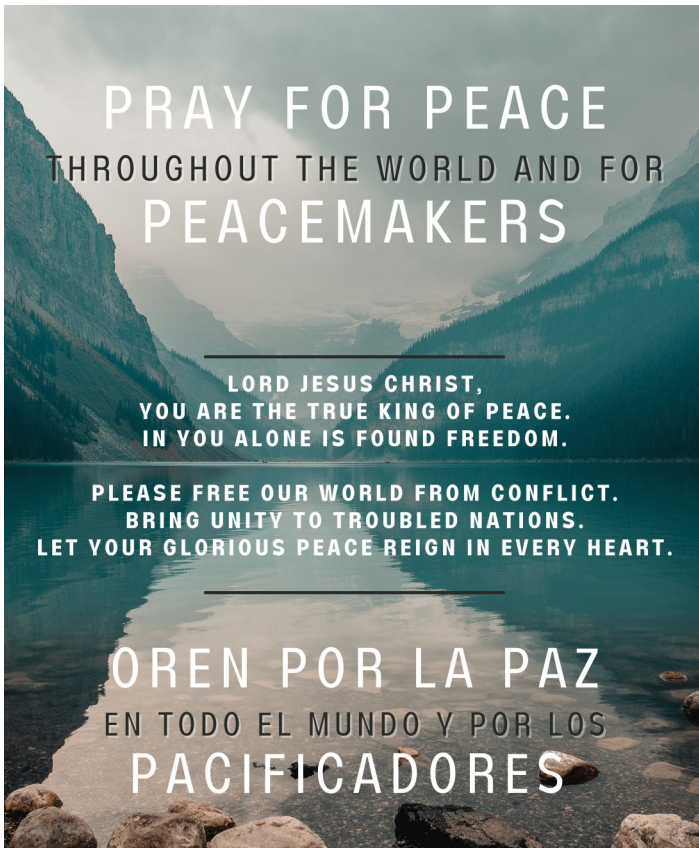

2024 has already proven to be an exciting year. The election cycle is in full swing as we approach November's presidential and congressional contests. 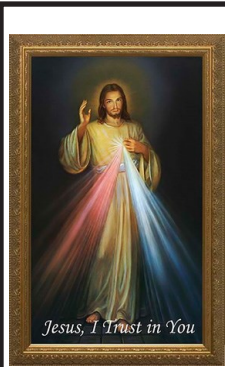
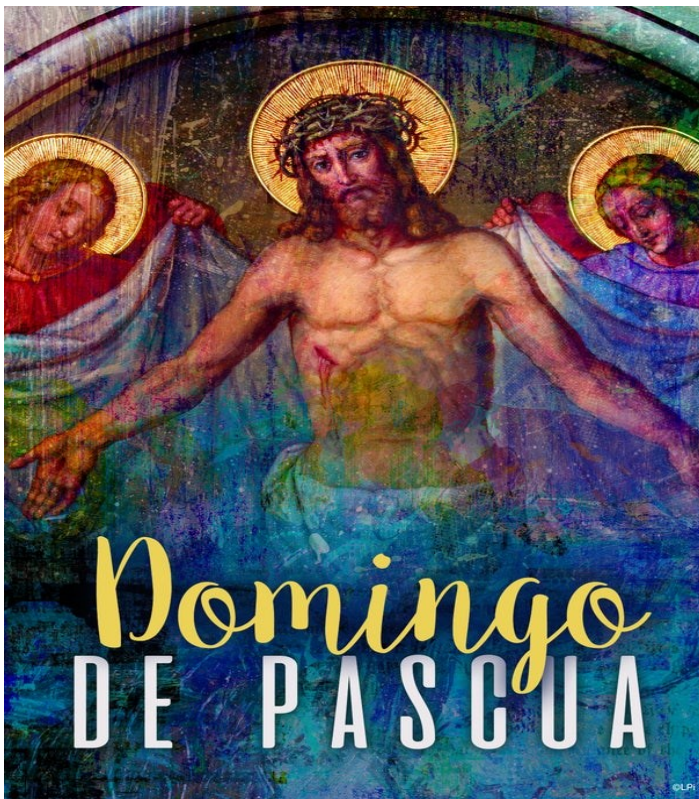
