




#### ST. JAMES COLUMBARIUM

# Bishop-elect Fabre will be installed April 29, 2022

Pope Francis has appointed Father Jacques Fabre, CS, as the 14th Bishop of Charleston. Bishopelect Fabre is a member of the religious order the Missionaries of St. Charles, or Scalabrinian Fathers. "I am humbled to be named Bishop of Charleston and look forward to serving the people of South Carolina," said Bishop-elect Fabre. "As shepherd, it is my hope to work together to strengthen our Church and project God's love to all who we encounter."

Bishop-elect Fabre was born on Nov. 13, 1955, in Port-Au-Prince, Haiti. He immigrated to New York City and completed his secondary education. He joined the Scalabrinians and took first vows in 1982, and was ordained a priest Oct. 10, 1986. Over the past 35 years, Bishop-elect Fabre has served in many places — such as Cuba, Colombia, Rome and the Dominican Republic — and in a variety of roles. He was serving as administrator of Mission San Felipe de Jesus in Forest Park, Ga., when he received the call to become the Bishop of Charleston. He speaks five languages including English, Spanish, Italian, French and Creole. Bishop-elect Fabre will be ordained and installed on April 29. Please join me in praying for his ministry:

God, eternal shepherd, you tend your Church in many ways and rule us with love. You have chosen your servant, Jacques, to be a shepherd of your flock. Give him a spirit of courage and right judgment, a spirit of knowledge and love. By governing with fidelity those entrusted to his care, may he build your Church as a sign of salvation for the world. Amen.

EL OBISPO ELECTO FABRE TOMARÁ POSESIÓN EL 29 DE ABRIL

El Papa Francisco ha nombrado al Padre Jacques Fabre, CS, como el 14º Obispo de Charleston. El obispo electo Fabre es miembro de la orden religiosa de los Misioneros de San Carlos, o Padres Scalabrinianos. "Me siento honrado de ser nombrado obispo de Charleston y espero poder servir a la gente de Carolina del Sur", dijo el obispo electo Fabre. "Como pastor, espero trabajar juntos para fortalecer nuestra Iglesia y proyectar el amor de Dios a todos los que encontramos".

El obispo electo Fabre nació el 13 de noviembre de 1955 en Port-Au-Prince, Haití. Emigró a la ciudad de Nueva York y completó su educación secundaria. Se unió a los Scalabrinianos y tomó sus primeros votos en 1982, y fue ordenado sacerdote el 10 de octubre de 1986. Durante los últimos 35 años, el obispo electo Fabre ha servido en muchos lugares, como Cuba, Colombia, Roma y la República Dominicana. y en una variedad de roles. Se desempeñaba como administrador de la Misión San Felipe de Jesús en Forest Park, Georgia, cuando recibió el llamado para convertirse en obispo de Charleston. Habla cinco idiomas, incluidos inglés, español, italiano, francés y criollo.

El obispo electo Fabre será ordenado e instalado el 29 de abril. Únase a mí para orar por su ministerio: Dios, eterno pastor, cuidas de tu Iglesia de muchas maneras y nos gobiernas con amor. Has elegido a tu siervo, Jacques, para que sea el pastor de tu rebaño. Dale un espíritu de coraje y buen juicio, un espíritu de conocimiento y amor. Gobernando con fidelidad a los que le han sido confiados, edifique tu Iglesia como signo de salvación para el mundo. Amén.


