



recent Pew Forum survey revealed the startling statistic that 69% of Catholics do not believe in the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist. For the majority of Catholics today, the Eucharist is merely a symbol of Christ, and the Mass is merely a collectivity of likeminded individuals gathering to remember his life. This indicates a

spiritual disaster, for the Eucharist is "the source and summit of the Christian life." In response to this crisis, Bishop Robert Barron, then the Chair of the Committee on Evangelization and Catechesis for the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, began working with his brother bishops on a solution. From these conversations, the National Eucharistic Revival was born. This Is My Body: A Call to Eucharistic Revival is designed to accompany that revival. In this brief but illuminating text, Bishop Barron offers a threefold analysis of the Eucharist as sacred meal, sacrifice, and Real Presence, helping readers to understand the sacrament of Jesus' Body and Blood more thoroughly so that they might fall in love with him more completely. Discover the profound truth flowing out of Jesus' words at the Last Supper: "Take, eat; this is my body. . . . Drink from it, all of you; for this is my blood of the covenant.'

COLUMBARIUM EXPANSION

The Columbarium Committee has been planning an expansion. In researching the funds needed, it became known that **costs have** doubled since we built the columbarium in 2007. The \$2,900 cost for a niche (holds two cremated remains) has been unchanged for all those years, but that cost will now have to increase to \$3,900 effective July 1, 2023, in order to fund the expansion. If you have been contemplating buying a niche in our columbarium, we suggest you do it in the month of June to save yourself some money. A reminder that \$2,500 of the \$3,900 niche purchase price is tax-deductible.

A three year (36 month) time payment plan is available. Please contact Paula at the Parish Office to obtain more info, to purchase a niche, or to begin a time payment plan.



ESTÉ BUSCANDO ESTE LIBRO EN LAS PRÓXIMAS SEMANAS

Una encuesta reciente de Pew Forum reveló la sorprendente estadística de que el 69% de los católicos no creen en la Presencia Real de Cristo en la Eucaristía. Para la mayoría de los

católicos de hoy, la Eucaristía es simplemente un símbolo de Cristo, y la Misa es simplemente una colectividad de personas de ideas afines que se reúnen para recordar su vida. Esto indica un desastre espiritual, porque la Eucaristía es "la fuente y cumbre de la vida cristiana". En respuesta a esta crisis, el obispo Robert Barron, entonces presidente del Comité de Evangelización y Catequesis de la Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos, comenzó a trabajar con sus hermanos obispos para encontrar una solución. De estas conversaciones nació el Avivamiento Eucarístico Nacional. Este es mi cuerpo: un llamado al avivamiento eucarístico está diseñado para acompañar ese avivamiento. En este texto breve pero esclarecedor, el obispo Barron ofrece un análisis triple de la Eucaristía como comida sagrada, sacrificio y Presencia Real, ayudando a los lectores a comprender más a fondo el sacramento del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Jesús para que puedan enamorarse más de él. completamente. Descubre la profunda verdad que brota de las palabras de Jesús en la Última Cena: "Tomad, comed; este es mi cuerpo. . . . Bebed de ella todos; porque esto es mi sangre del pacto."
