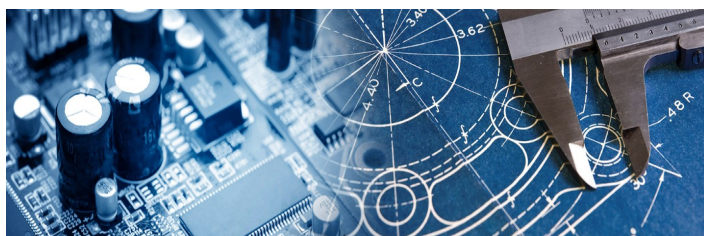

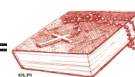

**Anointing  
of the Sick**

**SACRAMENT OF THE SICK REQUEST:** This is the proper name for what is sometimes mistakenly called "Last Rites" or "Extreme Unction." It is meant for anyone who has a serious illness, is facing surgery, or even is dealing with the effects of old age. It should not be limited to the dying. As the Letter of James says clearly, "Are there any who are sick among you? Let them send for the priests of the Church, and let the priests pray over them, anointing them with oil in the name of the Lord..." It is a sacrament of healing for spirit, mind, and often body. It is administered at a monthly Mass, usually on the first Wednesday, and anytime on request.

#### **NATIONAL GUN VIOLENCE AWARENESS DAY AND WEAR ORANGE WEEKEND, JUNE 3-5, 2022:**

National Gun Violence Awareness Day is commemorated on the First Friday in June and starts the Wear Orange Weekend. Orange was the favorite color of 15-year-old Hadiya Pendleton who was shot and killed after school one afternoon in a case of mistaken identity in 2013. This year, National Gun Violence Awareness Day will be June 3, 2022. Throughout our nation we honor the more than 110 lives taken by gun violence, and the additional 200+ who are shot and wounded every day. In 2019, firearm injury became the leading cause of death for youth aged 0-19 in the United States. We invite everyone to wear orange to honor those whose lives have been taken, to support survivors of gun violence, and to commit to work toward a future free from gun violence. There will be a Gathering of Remembrance and Stop the Violence Rally at the Myrtle Beach SkyWheel, on Friday, June 3, at 8:00PM.

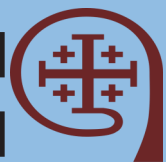

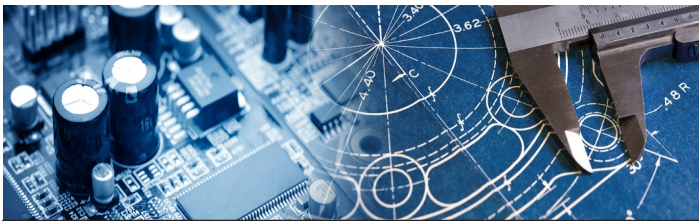
