SEEDS OF JOY ADVENT TRADITION

The youth ministry will be selling the Seeds of Joy this year in memory of Jim Molenda as a fundraiser to support our youth. This fun Christmas tradition is a great way to keep Christ and service at the center of your holiday season while preparing your heart for the baby Jesus! Better yet, it's so simple! 
