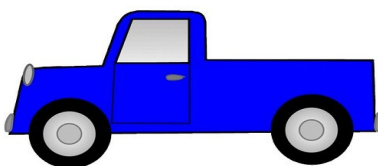

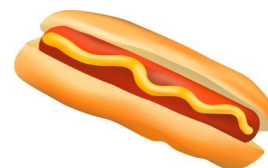


## SWEETS FOR THE SOUL Trunk or treat!! DRESS UP LIKE A SAINT

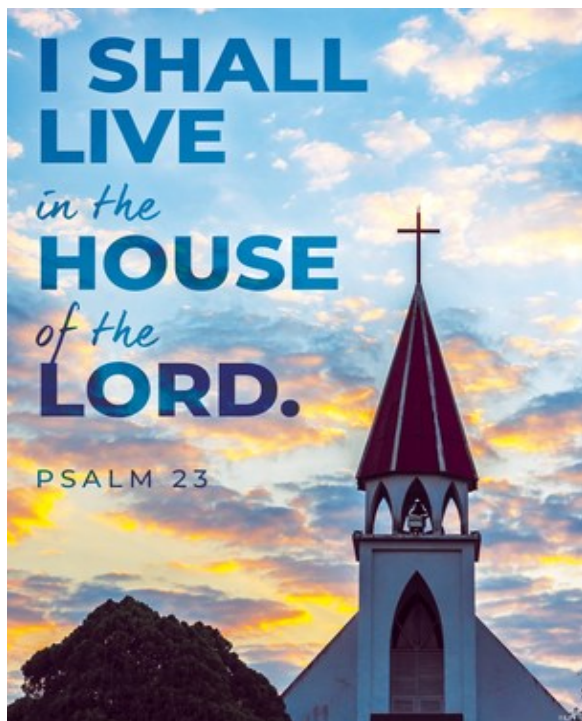
