Guidelines for requesting Masses:

- All Masses must be requested through the parish office.
- If a Mass has already been requested on a particular weekend for an intention, we cannot accept another request for the same intention.
- A requester cannot request more than one Mass intention per weekend with a MAXIMUM of ONE weekend request per month and MAXIMUM of FOUR weekends per year.
- These rules do not apply to weekday Masses.
- Customary offering: Weekday Masses \$10; Weekend Masses \$15; Holy Day Masses \$15.

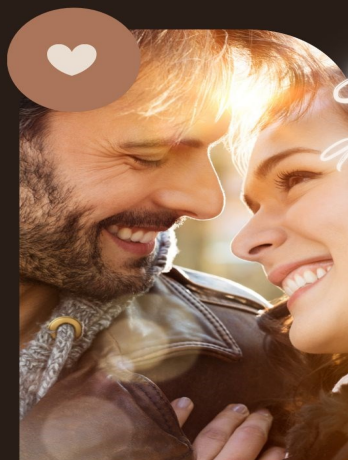
