ST. JAMES COLUMBARIUM

With the final three niche units (Units B, D & F) install for our columbarium, we have seven such units now in place. We have a total of 336 niches in the columbarium. We still have niches available. Remember each niche, which measures 12" x 12" x 12", can hold two cremated remains. The cost for a niche is \$2,900 with \$2,000 of that amount being tax deductible. If you have not already thought about our columbarium as a final resting place, now may be the time to begin. Take a minute and visit our beautiful Columbarium located on sacred grounds. 
