7 THEMES OF CATHOLIC SOCIAL TEACHING

Catholic social teaching is a central and essential element of our faith. Its roots are in the Hebrew prophets who announced God's special love for the poor and called God's people to a covenant of love and justice. It is a teaching founded on the life and words of Jesus Christ, who came "to bring glad tidings to the poor...liberty to captives....recovery of sight to the blind" (Lk 4:18-19), and who identified himself with "the least of these," the hungry and the stranger (cf. Mt 25:45). Catholic social teaching is built on a commitment to the poor. This commitment arises from our experiences of Christ in the eucharist. In the coming weeks, we will share the 7 Themes of Catholic Social Teaching that we are called to follow in light of Jesus' ministry and his call to follow in his footsteps.




