MASS INTENTION REQUEST JULY -DECEMBER 2024

2024 MASS BOOK: On **Monday, MAY 6**, we will begin taking request for Mass intentions for the **LAST 6 months of the year**. We will take request for the months of July through December 2024. We will take requests for these months only in the office during parish office hours **9:30AM-2:00PM**, on Monday, May 6. **NOTE: We will take phone calls for requests on Tuesday, May 7 during office hours. No phone request will be taken on Monday, May 6. After May 6, all request can be made in person or by phone 9:30AM-3:30PM.**

Guidelines for requesting Masses:

- All Masses must be requested through the parish office — **ONLY MASS REQUEST FOR JULY THROUGH DECEMBER 2024 will be taken.**
- If a Mass has already been requested on a particular weekend for an intention, we cannot accept another request for the same intention.
- A requester cannot request more than one Mass intention per weekend with a **MAXIMUM of ONE weekend request per month and MAXIMUM of TWO weekends per six months.**
- A requester cannot request more than 6 weekday Masses in this six month period of open Masses July through December 2024.
- Customary offering: Weekday Masses \$10; Weekend Masses \$15; Holy Day Masses \$15.

WERE YOU ASKED TO BE A SPONSOR FOR SOMEONE'S BAPTISM OR CONFIRMATION?

Did you know that you have to qualify to be a sponsor at most Catholic Churches?

St. James has its own sponsor form that needs to be filled out, and signed by Fr. Oscar before you can be a sponsor. Here are some of the things that you need to qualify:

- Roman Catholic.
- At least 16 years old.
- Received Confirmation and Holy Communion and attach your confirmation certificate.
- Free to receive Holy Communion when you go to Mass.
- Someone other than the parent.
- Member of the church and actively attending Mass every week.
- If Married, married in the Catholic Church and attach your marriage certificate.
- If single, not living with another person in a romantic relationship or as a couple.

If you have been asked to be a Godparent or Sponsor for Confirmation get the form and fill it out and see Fr. Oscar after a Mass for him to sign it.
