CHANGES TO MASS BOOK REQUEST—PLEASE READ

2024 MASS BOOK: On **Monday, October 2**, we will begin taking request for Mass intentions for the **first 6 months of the year**. We will take request for the months of January through June 2024. We will take requests for these months only in the office during parish office hours **9:30AM-12:00 Noon**, on Monday, October 2. **NOTE: We will take phone calls for requests on Tuesday, October 3, from 9:30AM-12:30PM.** No phone request will be taken on Monday, October 2.

Guidelines for requesting Masses:

- All Masses must be requested through the parish office — **ONLY MASS REQUEST FOR JANUARY THROUGH JUNE 2024 will be taken.**
- If a Mass has already been requested on a particular weekend for an intention, we cannot accept another request for the same intention.
- A requester cannot request more than one Mass intention per weekend with a MAXIMUM of ONE weekend request per month and MAXIMUM of TWO weekends per six months.
- A requester cannot request more than 6 weekday Masses in this six month period of open Masses January through June 2024.
- Customary offering: Weekday Masses \$10; Weekend Masses \$15; Holy Day Masses \$15.
- **We will open the book for the months of July through December 2024 in May 2024. Look for this announcement again in April 2024. We are hoping this will help us keep more control of the book and help us not run out of Masses early in the year.**

PARISH NURSE MONTHLY HEALTH AWARENESS TIP FOR SEPTEMBER:

This month's health tip goes out to all the men in our lives. September is Prostate Cancer Awareness Month. Although it may be an uncomfortable subject, we must be aware that in 2019 (most recent data) prostate cancer had the highest amount of new cases than any other cancer in men. Many prostate cancers grow slowly, do not cause any health problems and are not fatal. That is not always the case. Discuss screening with your family doctor by age 40-50. Screening will depend on age, family history and symptoms. Risk factors include advancing age, inherited genetic mutations, family history, diet high in animal fats/minimal vegetables and race. Black males have higher risk of developing and dying from the disease. To help prevent this cancer eat a diet with minimal red meat, sugar, dairy and processed foods. Try more broccoli and cauliflower, exercise, avoid smoking, stress and megavitamins. Fortunately, non-cancerous conditions such as Benign Prostatic Hypertrophy (BPH) and infection of the prostate do not increase your risk for this cancer. Warning signs include urgent or frequent urination especially at night, interrupted urine stream, dribbling, weak flow, painful or burning urination, blood in urine, rectal pain or difficulty with intimacy. 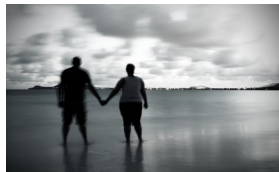
