# A Guidebook for 8<sup>th</sup> Grade/Year 2 Confirmation Candidates And Their Parents 2019-2020

Catholic Church of St. James

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We look forward to sharing your journey of faith as you prepare to receive the sacrament of Confirmation next year. This preparation involves spiritual growth, learning, service to others, and fellowship with other Catholic teens.

Confirmation, together with Baptism and Eucharist, form the Sacraments of Initiation. In the Sacrament of Confirmation, the baptized person is "sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit," and is strengthened for service to the Body of Christ. When you were baptized, your parents promised to raise you in the Catholic faith. At Confirmation, you will receive and celebrate the transforming grace of the Holy Spirit.

#### The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) Guidelines Regarding Confirmation

The bishops clearly state in the *National Directory of Catechesis* that:

- Confirmation preparation must call Christians to a real relationship with Jesus, the Father, and the Holy Spirit through a "vigorous sacramental life, prayer, study, and service."
- The Faith Community, made up of the pastor, parents, and other committed adults, has the primary obligation to provide programs and participate in preparing those to be confirmed.
- Parents are called to renew and strengthen their own faith. They must set an example of mature faith and involvement in their parish through their own efforts to grow spiritually and be of service to others.
- The program should include hours of service, retreats and renewal experiences, a letter of request, longer periods of preparation, and adult supervisors.

#### Who May Be Confirmed?

#### **The Confirmation Candidate:**

- Has received the sacraments of Baptism, Reconciliation, and Eucharist.
- Has a sincere desire to receive the sacrament.
- Participates weekly in the Eucharist.
- Is open to growing in faith.
- Has an adequate grasp of the basic content of the Catholic faith.
- Recognizes that he/she is a unique individual with gifts to offer and a willingness to share these gifts with the faith community.

Preparing for Confirmation
☐ Participate in Mass on Saturday evening or Sunday EVERY WEEK and on Holy Days of
Obligation.
☐ Attend Confirmation Family Class(es) with parent(s) when scheduled.
☐ Sign the Confirmation Covenant with parents.
☐ Participate in Confirmation classes.
• Since students in grades 7 & 8 are not required to attend class every week, they are
expected to attend all or almost all sessions. We understand that sickness, family
outings, and life in general may prevent them from attending a session. Please
contact the Office of Youth Ministry as SOON as you think your child may be
absent from a session.
☐ We highly encourage each parent to chaperone ONE session or the Junior High
Rally. While we understand that this is not feasible for every family, please make every
effort to have at least 1 parent present at a session/event/trip.
o Parents will need to be background screened and complete an online course in order
to chaperone any session/event.
☐ Attend the Junior High Rally on <b>Saturday, November 2, 2019</b> .
☐ Choose a sponsor (see <i>Confirmation Sponsor Requirements</i> page for full details).
☐ Create a biography and a poster of the saint chosen to be one's Confirmation name (due
January 5th, 2020) and present it at Newcomer's Welcome Reception (date to be
determined).
☐ Write a letter to Bishop Guglielmone and Fr. Oscar, requesting Confirmation (due <u>March</u>
<u>1, 2020</u> ).
□ Participate in the <b>Sunday, April 5<sup>th</sup>, 2020 Youth Mass at the 9:30 am Mass</b> .
☐ Complete and document stewardship and spiritual activities (due <b>September 13, 2020</b> ):
<ul> <li>5 hours or more of community and/or school service</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>8 hours or more of parish service</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>2 additional spiritual activities, or more</li> </ul>
☐ Attend the high school youth ministry program in Grade 9.
• The required number of times a student must attend the high school youth ministry
program will be determined once we know when Confirmation is.
☐ Participate with parent(s) in an interview with pastor and/or youth minister to determine
the candidate's readiness and desire to receive the sacrament (date to be determined).
☐ Attend the Confirmation Retreat in the fall of Grade 9 (date to be determined).
☐ Attend the Review Session and Confession Day in the fall of Grade 9 (date to be
determined).
☐ Attend the Confirmation rehearsal with parents, sponsor, or proxy (date to be determined;
always held the Sunday evening before Confirmation).
☐ Participate in Confirmation (date to be determined by the Bishop).

#### **Roles and Responsibilities of Parents**

"Parents have the first responsibility for the education of their children. (CCC 2223) Parents make that initial promise to raise their child in the Catholic faith when their child is baptized. Preparation for Confirmation continues that commitment.

Because parents are the primary educators of their children, parents are expected to:

- Worship with your family regularly.
- Encourage your child to complete assignments and activities.
- Encourage your child to pray about the decision to be confirmed.
- Pray for your child's spiritual growth every day.
- Bring your teen, and when necessary yourself, to meetings, programs, etc.
- Be involved in church activities.
- Explain that <u>Confirmation is not graduation</u>. By making the decision to be confirmed, students are agreeing to remain active in their faith and their parish community.

The Holy Spirit is waiting to rain down upon the entire family, along with your Confirmation candidate!

But grow in grace and in the knowledge of our Lord and savior Jesus Christ. To him be glory now and to the day of eternity. Amen. (2 Peter 3:18)

# Candidate's Letter of Request for Confirmation to the Bishop

Due date: March 1, 2020 or Before

The purpose of the letter is to give you the opportunity to express why you want to be confirmed.

The letter will be mailed to the bishop after being reviewed by the pastor.

#### Letter guidelines:

- Letter can be typed or written legibly in ink. It needs to be personally signed.
- Begin the letter by writing

#### **Date**

#### Dear Bishop Guglielmone and Father Oscar,

- Write three paragraphs:
  - 1. Tell why you want to be confirmed.
  - 2. Name the gift of the Holy Spirit that you want to receive more of, and explain why. (Choose from Wisdom, Understanding, Courage, Wonder and Awe, Knowledge, Right Judgment, Reverence.)
  - 3. Explain how you have prepared for Confirmation. Remember to include the acts of stewardship that you have performed, and how the project(s) helped you understand the value and importance of Christian service.
- Sign the letter with your full name.

#### **Confirmation Sponsor Requirements**

Your sponsor should be someone with strong faith, someone you are close to, someone you admire. Your sponsor can be from St. James, but they are not required to be.

#### A sponsor:

- Must be a fully initiated member of the Catholic Church, which means the person has received the sacraments of Baptism, First Communion, and Confirmation. If married, must be married in the Catholic Church.
- Must be an active, registered member of a parish, attending Sunday Mass and Holy Days of Obligation, and receiving Holy Communion regularly.
- Must be at least 16 years of age.
- Must be present at Confirmation.
- Must be a good role model to give a good example of mature Christian faith in action.
- Can be male or female.
- Must NOT be the parent of the candidate.

#### The sponsor will:

- Bring you forward to receive the sacrament.
- Present you to the Bishop for anointing.
- Help you to fulfill your baptismal promises under the influence of the Holy Spirit (From *The Rites of the Catholic Church*, vol. 1, p. 480.)

#### After you have chosen your sponsor,

- 1. Complete the top section of the **Confirmation Sponsor Form** and give it to your sponsor.
- 2. The Sponsor will fill out the "Sponsor's Statement of Faith" section and then send it to his or her parish to fill out the "Sponsor's Parish Certificate" section. Return the completed form AND a copy of his/her confirmation certificate (and marriage certificate, if married) to the St. James Office of Youth Ministry, Attn. Taylor Monahan, no later than Sunday, March 1, 2020.

#### For the Sponsor

You have been chosen to be a Confirmation sponsor. How wonderful! This Confirmation candidate admires you for your strong Catholic faith, and believes that you will be supportive as he/she continues his/her journey of faith. Here are a few suggestions on how to be the best possible sponsor you can be:

• **Confirmation Sponsor's Form.** Please fill out the "Sponsor's Statement of Faith" section and then send it to your parish to fill out the "Sponsor's Parish Certificate" section, *complete with parish seal*.

The completed form AND the Sponsor's Confirmation Certificate and Marriage Certificate needs to be sent back to the St. James Office of Youth Ministry, attn: Taylor Monahan, by March 1, 2020 or before.

- Be a good example of how a mature Catholic Christian lives.
- **Pray for your candidate and yourself.** Your prayers are important. Attend Mass together whenever possible.
- **Be generous.** Please write a letter of encouragement and support to your candidate. Offer a gift of spiritual significance a new Bible, rosary, or book about our faith or about the saint the candidate has chosen for a Confirmation name.
- Attend the Mass of Confirmation. At that Mass, you will bring your candidate forward to receive the sacrament, place your hand on your candidate's shoulder, and act as a witness when he/she is anointed by the bishop.
- Remember to stay in touch with your newly confirmed Catholic after the big day. Suggestions include remembering birthdays and the anniversary of this special day by sending a card or email or making a phone call. Encourage him/her to continue attending Mass, be a member of Youth Group, and stay involved in activities at church.
